



INFORMATION ON THE NEW EU REGULATION 2018/848 ON ORGANIC FARMING

Information for operators in third countries (outside the European Union) of the new EU Regulation 2018/848 on organic farming.

1. Summary

On May 30, 2018, the new Regulation (EU) 2018/848 was published. In the member states of the EU, this regulation entered into force in the European Union as of January 1, 2022, replacing Regulation (EC) 834/2007.

Should operators from countries located outside the European Union, and who produce for the European Union market, implement reg. 2018/848 right now?

For third countries (countries outside the European Union) there is a three-year transition period, so the new regulation will be mandatory only from January 1, 2025.

Mayacert has the obligation to inform that all operators must apply the EU regulation 2018/848 and may not use the Mayacert Ecological Regulation as an equivalent regulation and there is a period until December 31, 2024 for the transition. EU regulation 2018/848 must be applied in accordance with and repeals EU regulation 834/2007.

Do operators from third countries need a certificate that demonstrates compliance with regulation 2018/848 in order to export to the EU?

No not yet. By January 1, 2025, third country operators need a certificate ("MC") showing compliance with 2018/848. This is regulated by art. 57 of the new organic regulation 2018/848.

What does the change from equivalent certification to compliant certification (according to regulation 2018/848) mean for operators?

Operators are not yet required to implement new requirements. However, it is important that all operators assess their own production systems and check if they need to adapt their production system to the new organic certification requirements.

What's new for exports to the EU, from January 1, 2022?

The format of the Certificate of Inspection (COI) certificate for export to the European Union in TRACES (Trade and Control Expert System) has changed slightly.

Relevant information on COI can be found in <u>regulation (EU) 2021/2306</u>. In the annex of (EU) 2021/2306, you can find the new COI format. Which now must be created electronically through the TRACES system, and not as a paper version.

This is a requirement of regulation 2021/2306. It is also important to note that regulation 1235/2008 is no longer valid.

2. Brief introduction to the new regulation

2.1 Objectives of the regulation

Its objective is to review and strengthen the existing rules in the European Union (EU) relating to organic production and the labeling of organic products with regard to:

- the control system
- the trading system
- production standards.

In this way, it is proposed:

- establish a level playing field for operators
- harmonize and simplify standards
- increase consumer confidence in organic products and in the EU organic production logo.

2.2 Scope of application

It applies to the following products originating from agriculture, including aquaculture and beekeeping, (as listed in Annex I to the TFEU) and to products originating from them, when such products are produced, prepared, labelled, distributed, or marketed, imported into, or exported from the Union, or when destined for any of the foregoing:

- Live or unprocessed agricultural products, including seeds and other plant reproductive material
- processed agricultural products intended for human consumption
- cattle feed

It also applies to certain products closely linked to agriculture, listed in Annex I of EU Regulation 2018/848, when they are produced, prepared, labelled, distributed, marketed, imported into, or exported from the Union, or are going to be. And it also applies to any operator who, at any stage of production, preparation, and distribution, develops activities related to the aforementioned products.

2.3 Important Changes.

- The Regulation extends the scope of the current legislation on the production and labeling of organic products (Regulation (EC) No 834/2007) to cover other products that are closely linked to agriculture, such as cork, salt, essential oils, cotton or wool.
- Harmonizes the rules applicable to organic operators in EU Member States and third countries by introducing the **compliance system.**
- Simplifies access to the regime for small operators.
- Revises organic livestock production standards and introduces standards for new species such as rabbits.

2.4 Requirements

- maintain and enhance natural soil life and fertility, stability, water-holding capacity, and soil biodiversity
- use seeds and animals with a high degree of genetic diversity, resistance to disease and longevity
- choose plant varieties considering the particularities of specific organic production systems and paying special attention to agronomic performance and disease resistance
- choose animal breeds based on their genetic value, longevity, vitality and resistance to diseases or health problems
- apply a reproduction adapted to the place and linked to the soil.

3. Structure of changes in the EU regulation 2018/848.

Regulation (EU) 2018/848 is the basic standard, for which the European Parliament and the European Council are responsible. However, many details are defined in so-called "secondary legislation", made up of "delegated regulations" or "executing regulations", for which the European Commission is responsible. As of November 8, 2021, work began. The number of such "side acts" makes the current situation very confusing, but the Commission has promised that they will work on consolidating some of these rules over the next few months.

3.1 Implementing acts

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2020/464 establishes certain rules to apply Regulation (EU) 2018/848 with regard to:

- the documents necessary for the retroactive recognition of the periods for conversion purposes.
- the production of organic products.
- the information that Member States must provide to the European Commission.

Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2021/279 establishes rules for:

- official investigations in cases of suspected non-compliance.
- the size of the groups of operators and the documentation of their system of internal controls.
- minimum control requirements.
- the national catalog of measures in case of non-compliance.
- the exchange of information between the Member States and the Commission.

3.2 Delegated Acts

The Commission has adopted several delegated acts amending the annexes to Regulation (EU) 2018/848.

- <u>Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/427</u> amending Regulation (EU) 2018/848, Annex II, with regard to certain detailed production standards applicable to organic products. Which, in turn, was modified by Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/269.
- <u>Delegated Regulation (EU) 2020/1794</u> amending Regulation (EU) 2018/848, annex II, part I, regarding the use of plant reproductive material in conversion and non-organic.
- <u>Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/642</u> amending Regulation (EU) 2018/848, Annex III. with regard to certain information that must appear on the labeling of organic products.
- <u>Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/715</u> amending Regulation (EU) 2018/848 with regard to the requirements applicable to groups of operators.
- <u>Delegated Regulation (EU) 2021/716</u> amending Regulation (EU) 2018/848, annex II, in relation to organic production standards applicable to germinated seeds and endive buds, to feed for certain aquaculture animals and antiparasitic treatments in aquaculture.

Likewise, two delegated regulations complement the rules of Regulation (EU) 2018/848.
